

Piping Tip

# POSITIONS



## CLOSED

Point the narrow portion of the piping tip towards your head, heart, or chest for closed petals. Left-handed piping with a closed tip position will produce petals pointed towards the northeast, while right-handed piping will create petals pointed towards the northwest.



## NEUTRAL

Point the narrow portion of your piping tip directly upwards towards the ceiling. This position creates petals that point north on your petal compass.



## OPEN

Point the narrow portion of your piping tip away from you towards a corner where the ceiling meets the front wall, or towards a wall directly in front of you, or to the left or right. This position will create petals that range from slightly open to fully open, and they will be pointing towards the northwest, northeast, southwest, east or southeast on your petal compass.



## DOWNWARD

Point the narrow portion of the piping tip downwards towards your flower nail or the floor. This position is ideal for leaf tips, drop tips, round tips, or building bases and stability structures for petals.
